

GETTING THERE

Southern Arizona

ARAVAIPA CANYON PRESERVE is 50 miles northeast of Tucson. It can be accessed from the east or west ends of the canyon. For preserve questions, call (928) 828-3443. **NOTE: Access into Aravaipa Canyon from the preserve requires a permit from Bureau of Land Management. TO WEST ARAVAIPA

<u>From Tucson</u>: (70 miles) Take Oracle Road north to Oracle Junction, then take Highway 77 past Mammoth. Take right onto Aravaipa Road (before Dudleyville). The last ten miles is a gravel road.

<u>From Phoenix</u>: (120 miles) Take Highway 60 east to Superior, then go southeast on Highway 177 to Winkleman. Turn south onto Highway 77 for ten miles to Aravaipa Road. Turn left onto Aravaipa Road. The last ten miles is a gravel road.

TO EAST ARAVAIPA

<u>From Tucson:</u> (155 miles) Take I-10 east to Willcox exit 340. Turn left onto Fort Grant Road and go north 30 miles to Bonita. Turn left onto Klondyke Road and go 32 miles to Klondyke. Preserve entrance is seven miles past Klondyke. The last 38 miles is a gravel road and subject to closure during wet weather.

<u>From Phoenix</u>: (190 miles) Take Highway 60 east to Globe, then U.S. 70 south to Fort Thomas. Travel eight miles past Fort Thomas and turn right onto Klondyke Road. Travel 28 miles to Klondyke. Preserve entrance is seven miles past Klondyke. The last 38 miles is a gravel road and subject to closure during wet weather.

MULESHOE RANCH CMA is 30 miles northwest of Willcox. Take I-10 east to exit 340. Go south, turn right onto Bisbee Avenue, then right onto Airport Road. Go north for 15 miles to junction just past mailboxes, bear right and continue 14 miles. Turn left into the Headquarters. 520-212-4295

PATAGONIA-SONOITA CREEK PRESERVE is 60 miles southeast of Tucson. Take I-10 east to Highway 83 exit south. At Sonoita, turn west on Highway 82. In Patagonia, turn west on 4th Avenue. Turn south on Pennsylvania, cross the creek, and go about one mile to the entrance. (520) 394-2400

RAMSEY CANYON PRESERVE is about 90 miles southeast of Tucson, near the city of Sierra Vista. Take I-10 east to Highway 90 exit. Go south to Sierra Vista. Take Highway 92 south from Sierra Vista for six miles and turn right on Ramsey Canyon Road. The preserve is at the end of Ramsey Canyon Road, four miles west of the highway. (520) 378-2785

CENTRAL ARIZONA

HASSAYAMPA RIVER PRESERVE is three miles southeast of Wickenburg. From central Phoenix, take I-17 north to the Highway 74 (Carefree Highway) exit. Go left on Highway 74 to Highway 60. Turn right onto Highway 60. From the westside of Phoenix, take I-10 west to the Cotton Lane/303 Loop exit. Continue on the 303 Loop to Highway 60. Turn left onto Highway 60 towards Wickenburg. The preserve is on the west side of the highway near milepost marker 114. (928) 684-2772.

Northern Arizona

HART PRAIRIE PRESERVE is located 13 miles north of Flagstaff. The preserve is open seasonally for guided nature walks and for mission-related groups conducting workshops, retreats or conferences. (928) 774-8892
